**Q:** If we bring spare parts do they need to be included in the “box”?

**A:** Read the Rules under General Mission Specification and Notes highlighted in red. If the aircraft is “damaged”, that flight does not count. You may make repairs prior to a new flight attempt. “Repairs” must be that, repairs to the original aircraft, not replacement with spare parts. For example, you must repair a damaged wing, you can not replace it in whole with a spare wing. Limited spare parts, motors, propellers, etc may be used and they do not need to be included in the “box”.
